LKYGBPC Smart City Grand Prize (Category 0 to 1)

The **LKYGBPC Smart City Grand Prize (Category 0 to 1)** will be awarded to the best and most innovative pre-revenue teams/startups with novel technology or business model innovations across all areas of focus.

Selected by a panel of Grand Final Judges, the winning team will receive cash prize that is equity-free, non-dilutive and without any strings attached.

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LKYGBPC Smart City Grand Prize (Category 1 to ∞)

The **LKYGBPC Smart City Grand Prize (Category 1 to ∞)** will be awarded to the best and most innovative revenue-generating early stage start-ups across all areas of focus.

Selected by a panel of Grand Final Judges, the winning team will receive cash prize that is equity-free, non-dilutive and without any strings attached.



DBS Foundation Social Impact Prize

[DBS Foundation](#) is an endeavour from DBS Bank to make an even greater impact in addressing Asia's evolving social needs. The Foundation believes that businesses can create impact by finding innovative solutions to social problems while also pursuing a profit bottom line.

DBS Foundation supports such social enterprises (SEs) – businesses for good with capacity building, grant support, financing and mentoring. To date the Foundation has awarded grants to over 100 SEs and nurtured 300+ SEs through other support programmes.

The **DBS Foundation Social Impact Prize** will be awarded to the most innovative business plans / start-ups / early-stage ventures that address pertinent urban social challenges faced by cities of today.

If you have a business idea that can help solve crucial social issues facing our cities, please apply with an executive summary detailing:

- What social challenge does your business solution address and why is it important to solve?
- How will your business idea address and solve this challenge?
- How will you ensure impact created by executing your idea is sustainable, scalable and measurable?
- Please note that the social impact of your business plan must have applicability in Asia.

Evaluation Criteria:

Along with the overall evaluation criteria set for the Global Business Plan Competition, your entry will also be evaluated on the following, to qualify for this category:

- Identification of the social problem.
- Creativity in addressing the social challenge and stakeholders involved.
- Measurement and sustainability of social impact.
- Business solution with scalable social enterprise model.

Kajima Smart Construction Deployment Prize

The [Kajima Corporation](#) (KAJIMA) is a large building and construction company with 180 years of history in construction industry, typically involved in leading large scale projects. The company builds commercial, residential, institutional buildings and infrastructures. Its portfolio in Singapore includes Resorts World Sentosa.

The **Kajima Smart Construction Deployment Prize** will be awarded based on selection by members of the Kajima Group including subsidiaries expanding worldwide.

The prize will be awarded to the most innovative business plans / technologies / start-ups / early-stage ventures that are relevant to real estate development and construction projects. The award winner will receive not only opportunities to demonstrate the concept in actual projects in Singapore or Japan, but also the costs required to these activities (worth up to 30K SGD).



Sino-Singapore Nanjing Eco Hi-tech Island Investment Prize

The [Sino-Singapore Nanjing Eco Hi-tech Island](#) (SNEHTI) is a township development supported by the two governments of Singapore and Jiangsu. The island aims to be an “Eco Hi-tech city, Low Carbon Smart Island” which focuses on innovative, high tech and sustainable development.

The **Sino-Singapore Nanjing Eco Hi-tech Island Investment Prize (SNEI)** will be awarded based on selection by members of the Sino-Singapore Nanjing Eco Hi-tech Island Development Co.

Finalists that are flown into Singapore for the competition will be eligible for this prize. Winner of the SNEI prize will not only receive an investment term sheet from SNEI, but also the opportunity for test-bedding solutions at the AI-focused, low-carbon smart island in Nanjing.



NSCC Supercomputing Resource Prize

The [National Supercomputing Centre](#) (NSCC) Singapore was established in 2015 and manages Singapore’s first national petascale facility with available high performance computing (HPC) resources to support science and engineering computing needs for academic, research and industry communities.

The **NSCC Supercomputing Resource Prize** will be awarded to five finalist teams. Each awardee will be provided with a 2-month Gold Package subscription.

The Gold Package Subscription includes:

- Number of user accounts: 5
- Maximum active jobs per user: 100
- Maximum active jobs per tier: 500
- Maximum CPU-cores per job: 800
- Maximum wall time per job: 24 hours
- Access to long queue: Yes
- Job queueing priority: High
- Indicative maximum CPU hours: 50,000
- Storage quota per tier (GB): 3,000



Protege Futurist Investment Prize

[Protégé Ventures](#) is Southeast Asia's first student-run venture fund. It was launched in partnership with Kairos ASEAN, a Singapore-based social enterprise dedicated to finding and empowering young entrepreneurs. Established in 2017, Protégé Ventures aim to nurture the next generation of Venture Capitalists within the region through investing in great student ventures and grooming students into outstanding student VCs.

The **Protege Futurist Investment Prize** is awarded to bold teams with a unique conviction of the future and a strong team for execution. The award is open to all teams incorporated in Singapore.

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Crowd favourite by voting, winner of the **People's Choice Award** will receive cash prize that is equity-free, non-dilutive and without any strings attached.
